

I Margaret Kingswood relict of the late Jacob Kingswood of Caarendon County, Sumter district in the State of South Carolina, planter, do make this my last will & testament in the following manner, to wit:

First, to my ~~dearly~~ beloved sisters Susannah Richbourg & Isabella L. Nelson & their heirs I bequeath the Negrefs Zilpha (now about thirty six years of age) till she shall have completed her fiftieth year, when she shall have been liberated in the manner prescribed by law, and also her children or issue to be apprised ^{the value} and equally divided among the said Isabella L. Nelson & Susannah Richbourg & their heirs so that the children of the said Zilpha may not be separated from her who is their mother, at my death.

Secondly, It is my will that the following negroes, viz. Peter, Lucy, Neptune, Sailor & Charlotte be Set free at my death in as full & ample a manner as the Laws of this State will admit. And that Mingo the Son of the aforesaid Charlotte be also liberated when he shall have been fifty years of age, he being now about twenty eight years old, and that he be not separated from his mother, but remain with the said Susannah Richbourg, or with Isabella L. Nelson or their heirs, according to their agreement: And that Claudius Richbourg & Jared L. Nelson shall have the management of them.

Richbourg & Jared L. Nelson the Executors of this my last will & testament: And I moreover give & bequeath my riding chair, & harness unto Mrs Harriet White in consideration of my esteem.
