

Be it known to all whom it may Concern that I Mary Anderson of the State and District Aforesaid being at this time sick of body but of Sound disposing Mind and memory do make constitute and ordain this my last will and testament as follows -

Item first I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Susannah Amanda Anderson my riding Chair and horse Buck. Item second I give to my grand Son Joseph R. Anderson a two years Old sorrel Filly the Above Legacys to be taken care of by their Father D. D. Anderson: thirdly I will and bequeath to the children of my Son Daniel D. Anderson all the children that he now has living or may hereafter have one negro woman named Elsey with her five children she now has living with their future Increase to be under their care and control of my after named Executors during the minorship of Said Children and as they Come to lawful age or Marry the Said negroes with their increase to be appraised by three or five disinterested free holders to be nominated by my Executors each one to have his equal share or dividind of S^d negroes successively untile all shall arrive to age or Marry. and it is my will that my Son Daniel D. Anderson be entitled to receive all the benefit that ^{may} arise from the hire or labor of the above named negroes for the Support of his family during his natural life - and it is my will also that my Executors hire out Annually two other negroes namely Charles and Harry belonging to S^d Children and to be kept hired out during the natural life of my S^d Son Daniel D. Anderson and the profits arising therefrom to be applied in Support of his family as aforesaid and Tuition of S^d Children after which time the Children will be entitled to the S^d two negroes by the will of their late Grand Father Joseph Anderson. Lastly; it is my Will that after my Just debts are paid that all the remainder of my Estate be equally ^{divided} between my other two Sons Edward Anderson & Joseph W. Anderson to them and their heirs forever, and I do hereby nominate and appoint Edward Anderson Joseph W. Anderson my two Sons and my friend Absalom Wilson Executors to this my last will.
