I give and bequeath to Francis Johnson Son of Jos. <sup>h</sup> and Catharine  
Johnson of Charleston and the State aforesaid one thousand Dollars  
to him and his Heirs forever - -----

I give and bequeath to each of my true friends Robert Brailsford  
and Alexander W. Garden one gold Watch, Chain, Seal and Key as each  
of them may think proper to purchase in token of the respect I  
~~have~~ for them to them and their heirs forever - ~~I give and bequeath~~

to my Friend Alexander W. Garden the note of hand of his now in  
my possession - - - -----

I give and bequeath to the said Robert Brailsford my new Waggon  
with all the Giers thereunto attached to him and his heirs forever  
Item it is my Will that my House with all the furniture therein  
contained be kept at the exclusive direction and in charge of my  
Friend Alexander W. Garden untill my Son Thomas arrives at the age  
of twenty one years and no longer Item I leave to Mrs Mary Col-  
clough widow of Alexander Colclough dec. <sup>d</sup> all my wearing apparel  
and other paraphernalia with the exception of my Watch -----

I give and bequeath to Mrs. Leucracia Davis and Mrs. Elizabeth  
Morgan fifty Dollars to be equally divided betwixt them -----

I give and bequeath to my beloved Son Thomas all the rest and re-  
sidue of my Estate both Real and personal to him and his heirs for-  
ever but it is my will that in case of the death of my Son Thomas  
before he arrives to the age of twenty one then the whole of my

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property bequeathed to my son Thomas be divided into three equal parts the one third part of which I give to my Friend Joseph Johnfon of the City of Charleston and State aforesaid to him and<sup>third</sup> his Heirs forever . One other part I give and bequeath to My Friend Robt Brailsford of the Destrict and State aforesaid - the remaining one third part I give and bequeath to the Commifsioners of the Orphan House of Charleston for the use of that Institution to them and their Succesors in Office forever -----  
I give and bequeath to my friend Doc. John Boyd two Silver Turenes to him and his heirs forever in testimony of my regard for him-  
I do hereby authorize my Executors herein after named to give a reasonable compensation to my attending Servants for their attention to me during my last illness-----

Lastly I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint My Friends Alexander W. Garden, Robert Brailsford and Joseph Johnson my only and sole Executors to this my last will and Testament in witnefs whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 15th day of January in the Year of our Lord 1818 and in forty second year of the Independance of the united States of America -----
