In the name of God Amen---I Mary MacCollugh of Claremont County in Sumter District in the State aforesaid, Spinster, Considering the uncertainty of this Mortal Life, and being of a sound, perfect and disposing Mind and Memory, Blessed be God for the same, tho' weak in Body, do make and publish this to be my last Will and Testament, in manner and form following, That is to Say, First of all I recommend my Soul to Almighty God the Father and giver of all things hoping for Eternal happiness through the merits of my Blessed Redeemer Jesus Christ, my Body to be Intered at the discretion of my Friends; and as to my worldly-estate which God hath been pleased to bestow on me, I give and dispose of as follows--Imprimis. I will and order that all my just debts which I owe be fully paid as hereafter mentioned-- Item, I give and bequeath unto my daughter Judith White, a negro wench named Sue, her & her increase to her and her Issue forever. provided the exchange made with my son Samuel, of wench Dolly and Child Venus, for said Wench Sue and ditto Bella, should stand good, and in case it does, I give and bequeath unto my Son Samuel Grier a Boy named Billy to him and his lawful issue for ever. And if it should not continue to be an exchange, as before mentioned, in that case it is my Will and desire that my daughter---Judith White should have the Wench Dolly and her child Venus in the place of wench Sue, as before mentioned. Item. I give and bequeath unto my Son Thomas M.Grier, a negro fellow named Hardtige, to him and his lawful issue for ever--Item. I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Eliza MacCollugh five negroes, towit, Wench Bella, and girl Phobe, Wench Beck and her two Children Sophia and John, them and their increase to her and her Issue for every sumtan I give

this to be my last Will and Testament, in manner and form following, That is to Say, First of all I recommend my Soul to Almighty God the Father and giver of all things hoping for Eternal happiness through the merits of my Blessed Redeemer Jesus Christ, my Body to be Intered at the discretion of my Friends, and as to my worldly-estate which God hath been pleased to bestow on me, I give and dispose of as follows--Imprimis. I give and bequeath unto my Son Thomas M.Grier, a negro fellow named Hardtime, to him and his lawful issue for ever--Item. I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Eliza MacCollugh five negroes, towit, Wench Bella, and Girl Phoebe, Wench Beck and her two Children Sophia and John, them and their increase to her and her Issue for ever----Item I give and bequeath unto my son James M.Grier, a Mahogany Table, which is in his possestion at this time, to him and his issue forever-- Item. I give and bequeath unto my Grand Son William Gambol Grier a negro Boy named Struffon, to him and his lawful issue forever-- Item. It is my Will and desire that what ever part of Property may be coming to me from the Estate of Mr. Nathaniel MacCollugh, shall be equally divided between my grand Children, to wit, James Henry Britton, Mary Ann Britton, James Grier White, and Charlotte White

Share and Share alike, to them and their lawful issue forever---
Item. I give and bequeath unto my two Sons, Thomas M.Grier, and
Samuel Grier, each of them a Feather-Bed, furniture and Mattras,
to them and their lawful issue forever--Item. I give and bequeath
unto my grand daughter Mary Ann White a Feather-Bed, to her and
her lawful issue forever--Item. I give and bequeath unto my dau-
ghter Eliza MacCollugh the remainder of my Beds and Beding, that
were not before bequeathed, to her and her lawful issue forever--
Item. It is my Will and desire that if any of the persons above
named should die without leaving Issue, in that case, the Property
willed to the deceased person or persons to be equally divided
amongst the surviving Brothers and Sisters of the deceased, Share
and Share alike---Item. It is my will and desire that my Lands shall
be sold, either at Publick, or private sale, as those who may have
the Management of my Estate shall think best, and I give them power
to make Titles to the same--Item It is my will and desire that the
remainder of my Estate not already, or before bequeathed, shall be
sold at Publick Auction and the money arising from it, together,
with that from the Sale of the Land, to go in discharge of my just
debts--
