My Son Scarborough Executor of this my Last will and Testament heare by Revoakeing all other wills heare tofore by me made or Executed - Ratifying and Confirming this to be my Last will and Testament - in Testa- mony wheare of I have heareUnto Set my hand and Seal this this 10th-Day of January, 1807 -
