either of them Shall die before they shall have a Lawfull heit<sup>s</sup> their  
part shall Return to the others and I do hereby utterly Disallow  
Revoke and disannul all and Every other former te tament Wills Leg-  
asies and bequest By Mee in any wise Before Named or Willed. Rattify  
ing and Confirming this to be My Last will and Testament in witnefs  
whereof I have hereunto set My hand this six of desember in the  
year of our Lor one thousand<sup>and</sup> Eight hundred and five and in the  
in the ~~year~~ <sup>ninth</sup> twen<sup>ty</sup>tieth year of the Sovernnity and independence of  
the United States of America-----
