

MASON S. SPEARS

In the name of God amen. I Mason Spears Planter of Claremont County Sumter District, South Carolina, Considering the mortality of this mortal life, and being of sound and perfect mind and memory (blessed be almighty God for the same) do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following.

First I leave a Tract of Land lying on the Hills being a part of the Land which belonged to William Hampton Deceased to be sold to pay my Debts. Secondly, I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Elizabeth Spears one Negro man named Big Jim, one Negro Girl named Lender, also a Bed and furniture and my Riding Chair, and Chair horses named Canada in Lieu of her dower to be at her intire disposal either at Marriage or death. Thirdly, I give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Atkinson one Negro Girl named Milla and three hundred dollars to be levied out of my estate, with the increase of said negro girl. I further give and bequeath to my son Austin Spears two Negro oes named Jacob and Linda and increase. I further give and bequeath to my Daughter Aloaf Spears two Negroes named Anthony and Caty and increase. I further give and bequeath to my son Richard Hampton Spears two Negros named Sam and Hariot and increase. I farther give and bequeath to my Daughter Martha Greniry Spears two negroes named Prince and Rina and increase and I also give and bequeath to my son Theodore Mason Spears two Negroes named Adinal and Queser and increase These Legatees to be taken at marriage or the age of twenty one years. but if any of these Negroes should die, before taken into possestion then the Legatee shall takem another out of my Estate near the same value Fourthly I give and bequeath all the rest of my property real and Personal to remain for the support of my wife and children until my son Theodore Mason Spears shall arrive at the age of eighteen years, at which time all my property

Matha Greniry Spears two negroes named Prince and Rina and increase
and I also give and bequeath to my son Theodore Mason Spears two
Negroes named Amihal and Lueser and increase These Legacees to
be taken at marriage or the age of twenty one years. but if any
of these Negroes should die, before taken into possefson then
the Legatees shall takex another out of my Estate near the same
value Fourthly I live and bequeath all the rest of my property
real and Personal to remain for the support of my wife and child-
ren untill my son Theodore Mason Spears shall arrive at the age
of twenty-one-years eighteen years, at which time all my Estate
not particularly bequeathed above shall be equally divided among
my Six Children above mentioned, Excepting the Tract of Land and
improvements where I now live which I leave for the use of my
beloved wife during Widowhood together with all my stock and fur-
nature whatsoever, also any three Negroes not yet bequeathed
above according to her own choice. But it is my will that said

Tract of Land mentioned in this fourth article with improvements, stock, furniture, and three negroes shall return in to my Estate immediately after the marriage or death of my wife to be devided amongst my six children above mentioned by five judicious men as my Executors Shall Choose. And I do hereby appoint Jeremiah Pitts, Austin Spears and Littleton Atkinson Executors of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills by me made in witness where of I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty eighth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eleven and in the thirty fifth year of American Independence.

Signed sealed published and declared by the above named Mason Spears to be his last Will and Testament in presence of us who have hereunto subscribed our names as witnesses in presence of the Testator.

The word (Linder) in the eighth line interlined, and the words (twenty one years) in the twenty sixth line erased before signing.
