I Mathias James of Sumpter District Claremont County and State aforesaid, being though in a declining state of health, yet of a perfect soundness of mind and memory; knowing that life is uncertain, and that death is inevitable, I have thought it good, to constitute this to be my last will and testament, and desire it may be received by all as such; First I give up my soul to God, the author of my existence, hoping he will secure it to his everlasting kingdom.-- Desiring that my body may be decently buried, at the discretion of my executor; As to my money, my will and desire is to dispose of it, after the following manner; First I will, that all my lawful debts be paid.-- Secondly I will and desire that my niece, Rebecca B James the daughter of Walter James may have and to hold forever the balance of the said money, after the debts aforementioned are paid; Thirdly my will and desire is that my beloved brother, Walter James and his wife Esther James may have and to hold forever the Negro boy, by the name of Dave: I also will and desire that my Niece Elizabethannah James daughter of Walter James may have and to hold forever the Negro boy by the name of Bill. Fourthly my will and desire is that my Nephew Mathias James the son of Richard James may have and to hold forever the negro boy b. the name of Johnathanonly:- I also will and desire that my nephew John Mathias James the son of Walter James, may have and to hold forever, my chest of tools I also will and desire that my brother Walter James may have and to hold forever my wearing apparel; Fifthly and last-I constitute and appoint My Brother Walter Executor of t. is my last will and Testament:--In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the 19th day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty
