In the Name of God Amen

Feby 14th 1803

I Micajah Fitz Patrick of Sumpter District being Sick and weak in body but of perfect Mind & Memory Thanks be given unto God Therefore Calling unto mind the mortality of my body & knowing it is appointed for all men once to die Do make & appoint this my last will & Testament That is to say Principally & first of all I give & Recommend my sole unto the Hands of God that gave it & for my Body recommend it to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like Decent Manner at the Discretion of my Executor Nothing Doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty Power of God & as touching such worldly Affairs wherewith it hath pleased God blefs me in this life I give

bequeath & dispose of in the following Manner & form 1st It is my will and desire that all my lawfull debts be paid-----
2nd I give and bequeth unto my well beloved wife Nemima one negro woman Named Mymphs one Negrow gal named Dorkes & one Mare Cald Brunswick & one blackmare Cald gin all my stock of Cattle except 5 heffers all my Stock of Hogs all my household & Kitchen furniture except too beds and furniture & all my Plantation tools except my best ox & third best Plow and second best grub hoe to geather with all my land except too hundred acres on Trusleys branch to have as his one during his natural life and at his Death all to be sold except the lands holey whair I now live and the moneys to be Equally devided amongst my five Daughters Anney Penney Annat Susanna & Mary except one hundred dollars----

3rd I give & bequeth unto my Son Nathaniel a tract of land on Tresleys branch of too hundred acres & my bay mair & a heffer name hard bargon & a bed & furniture the third best Plow & my

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 Cald Brunswick & one blackmare Cald gin all my stock of Cattle
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 Tresleys branch of too hundred acres & my bay mair & a heffer
 name hard bargon & a bed & furniture the third best Plow & my
 best ax & my second best grub hoe my large sadel-----
 4th I give and bequeth unto my Daughtor Susanah a cow heffer
 name hart his and his increase-----
 5th I give & bequeth unto my Daughtor Mary one cow heffer named
 Lilley his and his increase-----
 6th I give unto my Son John the Track of land where I now live
 on and all joining to it after his mothers Death & a filley Cald
 fly and his increas & my small saddle & a cow heffer Cald pint
 his increase
 & a hundred dollars to be paid to him at the age of twenty one

or marriage & the Interest of it from his mothers Death
7th I give & bequeth unto Mif Sarah Adema one bead & furniture
& heffer named Rose and hir increase to be given hir at my wifes
Death I do hearby utterly revoke Disanul & Disallow all other
formar will by me made allowing this to be my laste will &
Testament & I doo also appoint John Frierson Executor & Executix
of this my last will & testament in witnefs wharof I have set
my hand & seal the year above mentioned.--
