I Moses Manning of said State and County being sick of body, but of sound & perfect mind & memory do constitute this my last will and testament in the following manner. & first I recommend my Soul into the hands of God who give it to me, & my body I commit to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like manner at the discretions of my after named Executors, And nothing doubting, but the general resurection I shall receive it again and the Union of Soul body be placed in an Etunal State I trust in happenefs--- And to such worldly Estate as has pleased God to belfs me with, I leave in the following manner----And first, I leave and bequeath to my beloved Wife Kezziah Manning all my Estate Real and Personal to her and for her own benefit during her natural Life, and at her own disposal at death--And I do hereby Constitute as my Executors Mark Lott, Manning, and my Extriz my Loving Kezziah Manning, and do revoke, & disannull all other Wills by me made, and confirm this as my Last Will & Testament
