I Noah Michau of Sumter District and State of South Carolina being weak in body but of perfect mind and memory and calling to mind the mortality of my body and mowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make and ordain this my last will not Testament, that is to say After my death I desire that all my just debts should first be paid.

Secondly ) I give and bequeath to my Sister Mrs Charlotte Lenud my Plantation or tract of Land whereon I now reside, also all my present crop except One hundred Bushels of Corn, also all my House hold and Litchen furniture except one feather Bed, also all my Plantation Tools of every discreption, also Three negroes namely Harbord, Cate and Leah, also One Bay Horse called Shackelford, also One half of my Stock of every discreption, also all my Poultry

Thirdly) I give and bequeath to my Brother Alexander Michau One Negro man name Talla, also One Black Horse, also One half of my Stock of of every discreption, also One hundred bushels of Corn, also One feather Bed also which may be due me either by Bonds, notes or accompts also all mywearing apparel, (Fourthly) The Said Charlotte Lenud and Alexander Michau above mentioned each to pay an equal part of my just debts------
