I Peter Haley of Clarendon County State of South Carolina planter) being Very Sick and Weak In body but of perfect mind and memory, thanks be given Unto God, Therefore Calling, to mind the Mortality of my Body and knowing, that it is appointed for all men once to Die do make and ordain this my last will and Testament, that is to say principally and first of all I Give and Recommend, my Soul into the hands of Almighty God Who Gave it and my body, I recommend to the Earth to be burried, in a decent Christian Burial at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter Named, nothing Doubting, but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again, by the mighty power of God)-and-Touching -Such Worldly Estate Wherewith it hath Pleased God to blefs Me with in this life, I give demise, and dispose of the same in the following, Manner and form.

Imprimis I give and Bequeath to my beloved Wife Mary Haley, the use of my property both Real and Personal, During the Time She Remains my Widow And no longer, for the use and Support of her and My beloved Children, and at her Death or Marriage Which may first happen, I give and bequeath the Whole of My property as above Mentioned, to my Beloved Children, Easter Haley, Mary Haley, & Peter Timothy Ridgway, to be delivered to them at the age of twenty one or on the Day of their Marriage to be Equally Devided between them Share and Share Alike, but if either of them Shall die under twenty. One Years of age and Without having living Issue of his or her body lawfully begotten, there Share or Part of my Estate is to Return to my Surviving Children, Share and Share alike and if all of my Said Children Shall Die Without leaving living Issue of his or her body lawfully begotten, then in Case of issue and he

One Years of age and Without having living Issue of his or her body lawfully begotten, there Share or Part of my Estate is to Return to my Surviving Children, Share and Share alike and if all of my Said Children Shall Die Without leaving living Issue of his ~~and~~ <sup>that</sup> her or their body lawfully begotten, then in Case I give and bequeath the whole of the property both Real and Personal to the lawfull begotten Issue of my Brotherinlaw Edmond Windam and his Wife Mary Windam, to be Equally Devided Between them Share and Share alike to them and their heirs forever -

Lastly I nominate and appoint. my Wife Mary Haley Executrix and my Friend Edward Windam Executor To this my last will and Testament, and Guardian and Trustees for my Said Children -
