In the name of God Amen I Richard Hampton of the State of South Carolina & Cleremont County being sick and Weak but of perfect sense and memory do make this my last Will and Testament. First I give my soul to God who gave it and my body to the Earth to be Decently buried at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter named and with what worldly Estate it has pleased God to blefs me with my Debts and funeral expences being first paid; I Dispose of as followeth: First I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Amy Hampton a negro Wench Named Vilet a negro Boy named Peter one negro Girl named peggy a ~~negro wench named Caty and Child named Sam~~ also three hundred and fifty acres of land lying on Green Swamp and a Small stock of Cattle and with all my household furniture: and I Do hereby nominate and appoint my beloved Wife Amy Hampton & William Hampton my executors to act for me to the best of their Discretion in Witnefs as hereunto I have set my hand and Seal this the twenty Eig^hth of ^{Day} November in the year of our lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety Six
