ecutors nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God And as touching

this life I give Demise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form

such wordly estate wherewith it has pleased God to blefs me in

First after my just Debts are paid it is my request that my Executors Shall Sell all my lands lying on Sammy Swamp in this manner (Viz) The purchaser Shall pay one third of the fortheren. the purchase money on the day of contract

one third more at the expiration of twelve months and the remaining third at the end of two years & I moreover request that they shall not take lefs than five thousand dollars for the land but

get as much more as they can they Shall also take a mortgage of the land with a bond mapproved security for the payment & them-

selves, give a forfeit bond for double the amount to make tittles after the full payment of the purchase money I also wish (if they should sell these lands) that they would purchase three hundred acres of land convenient to the Church & School house on Nasty Branch & Settle my family thereon And in case they should not sell ing that is is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last will and destament that is to Say principally
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my two daughters fourteen hundred dollars in cash in proportion to the value of their lots of of land each son inheriting his land as he becomes of age & makes payment accordingly to my daugh ters and should one or more of my sons not live to inherit their land the survivors shall pay so much more to my daughters as the judgement of my Executors shall think proper according to the value of their different lots of land Item. I give and bequeath unto my wife Elizabeth Harvin one Sorrel Horse Rdding Chair & Harnefs also one negro woman named Nanny during life or widowhood together and if my wife should marry the above Negro woman Nanny shall return to my Estate together with her increase Item.
