And for such worldly good things as it hath pleased God to Bless me with in this life I give bequeath and Dispose of in the following manner and form - - -

Imprimis I Will and desire that all my Lawful Debts be paid Item - - For Certain Reasons me hereunto Moving, it is my will and desire that my Children I had by my first wife do Receive from My Executors the sum of five Shilling Sterling Each for there full share of my Estate if Demanded

I Will and Desire that tract of land Containing one Hundred Acres on the South Side of Linches Creek Bounding on the Chandlers lands. to be sold and the money put to the schooling and support of the children

I will and desire that my negro girl Boss and her Increase be left to my wife her life tim and then her and increase if any to be Divided Among her Children that she now has

I will and Desire that my Stock of Cattle Horses hogs and Sheep be Kept to gather for the Support of my Family

I constitute and appoint Robert Tomlinson and Mary my wife Ex-

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I constitute and appoint Robert Tomlinson and Mary my wife Executor and Executrix of this my last will and Testament and I do hereby Revoke and Disannul all and Every other will or wills or ^{bequests} ~~bequests~~ by me here tofore made Declaring this and no other to be my last will and Testament . In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Fourteenth day of September in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and five -
