ROBERT DINGLE

In the name of God amen-----

Robert Dingle being now in health and in my right Senais God be thanked for his goodnefs to me but Calling to mind the mortality of the Boddy and knowing it is apointed for man onste to die-- I shere fore make this my last will & testament & first I recommend my soul into the hands of my griasious God who gave it in hopes of acceptance in the favour of God through Jesus Christ my Redeemer and as for what worlly goods it has been please God to blefs me with to live and bequeath in the following manner

It I give & bequeath to my loving wife Mary Dingle a track of land on Potatoc Creek of 150 acres granted to James Frierson--to her during life which shall be in law of all dowrs of my lands and at her death, shall return to my two sons Jas^s Hervey and Gabriel wealey also I give to my loving wife Mary Dingle the following slaves during life viz old Sam vilot Sandy & Milsy to have & to hold the same during life at her death to bee divided among all my Children--& not to bee removed out of this state

I I give & bequeath to My daughter Esther McKnight a part of a track of land joining lands of James Baron 2 sides & Crossing Potatoc Creek that part of the track from Lare gum Corner in the long branch up the branch to Amcos Thames is line Cornor thence up Thames is line to the old track & thence acrofs the creek and I also give to my Daughter esthur McKnight the slaves given her at Parage which wafs those John Tom--durrey--young--tom--acot--iley--mkey--bettey--^{Dooley} Appley--silvey--them & there increase for Ever--also the stock Cattle & hors--Household furniture which is her part in all except a share in some of my Slaves at my death-----

It I give & bequeath to my son Adam Dingle the track of Land bought of/ Robert & Live ise on Potatoc creek whare he now plants-& allso

... soul into the hands of my gracious God who gave it in hopes of
acceptance in the favour of God through Jesus Christ my Redeemer
... for what worldly goods it has been, please God to blefs me with
... and bequeath in the following manner

I give & bequeath to my loving wife Mary Dingle a track of Land
on Potatoe Creek of 150 acres granted to James Frierson--to her
during life which shall be in law of all dowrs of my lands and at
her death, shall return to my two sons Jas^s Hervey and Gabriel Wealey
also I give to my loving wife Mary Dingle the following slaves during
life viz old Sam vilot Candy & Miles, to have & to hold the same
during life at her death to bee divided among all my Children--& not
to bee removed out of this state

I give & bequeath to my daughter Esther Mcnigh a part of a
track of land joining lands of James Baron 2 sides & Crossing Potatoe
Creek that part of the track from bare gum Corner in the long branch
up the branch to Aleos Thames is line Cornor thence up Thames is
line to the old track & thence acrofs the creek and I also give to
my Daughter Esther Mcnigh the Slaves given her at Parage which
was those John Tom--durrey--young--tom--accol--iley--nkey--
^{Looney}etty--~~Splesu~~--Silvey--them & there increase for Ever--also the
stock Cattle & hors--Houshold furniture which is her part in all
except a share in some of my Slaves at my death-----

I give & bequeath to my Son Adam Dingle the track of Land bought
of Robert & Live rise on Potatoe creek where he now plants--& also
a track of land in Santee Swamp of 100 acres lying on the water plot
granted to Henry Drey to have & to hold the said two tracks of Land
as his part of my lands & also I give I give the following Negroes
to my Son Adam Dingle vis--Dick--rent--narrow--Zackas--Supied--Arch
guinecy--Charlottee--Sarey--hager--to have & to hold the afore said
lands & ten Slaves in free & Common Sockage alls the Cattle & hors
that he has had shall bee his part of the stock which Lands & Slaves

to my daughter Harriet Bradford the track of Land they now live on
granted to me allso a track adjoining granted to John Capps 200-acres
on Cudjois branch allso a track bought of Samuel Capps of 93¹/₂ which
said lands I give to her & her heirs for ever--allso I give to My
daughter Harriet Bradford the folloing slaves--vis--Pedrick Toney-
Ango- tepley- Albert--sarey--Polley & Amelia-binley & winter---allso
the Cattle & horsis which she has got & house hold furniture--which
said Slaves & Stock shall be her part & a part in Slaves when
she die.--Item I give to my son James Henry and my son Gabriel Wesley
all the remainder part of my land and each and every part of My Lands
shall to be theirs wholly and fully and shood they wish to devide
then that they do so without dispute & allso I give to my son James
Hervey Dingle the following Negroes vis--Sosbury--Salley--Lisah Tom--
Griah--John James--hill--sarey--mey--Rase--Samson--George--those twelve
Negroes to have & to hold in free & Common Usage Item I give to my
son Gabriel Wesley Dingle the following Slaves-- viz Isaac--Ciras
Abillah--& Little Ciras and Money--Judey--big Jo--Jack--little Sam--x
& Charlotte Bob & Pharo--those twelve Negroes a peace and the Lands be-
fore mentioned to them jointly Except Either of the two shood die
before he comes of age then there part of the Slaves shall be eq-
ually devided between them all but the survivor shall enjoy all the
land--I will that My old wench sarey shall be free at my Death
allso My by--Moses & my girl Clarinder that those three Negroes shall
be made free at My Death by my three Sons Adam Dingle--James Hervey &
Gabriel Dingle and that and find them Land out of the Lands left to
James Hervey & Gab^l wesleys land say out of the track that Isaac
Proze now live upon to work while they Live & that my son James
Henry act as gardion for them & pay the taxis for them as Slaves
tax & that they pay to him there taxis yearly & that the Stock we
now have of Cattle horsis mules hogs & Sheep shall be kept for the
use of my wife & Sons James Henry & gabriel wesly Dingle for the use
of the Plantation & the Money to be applied for the benefit of the
two boys and I apint for my Executors to act at My Death--James--Henry
