ROBERT MCKNIGHT

In the name of God Amen this 13th day of Nov. 1817.

I Robert McKnight of Sumter dis<sup>t</sup> being very sick & weak in body, but of a sound & perfect mind & Memory, do make & ordain this my last Will & testament. That is to say in the first place I give & recommend my Soul to God, my body to be decently buried -my worldly Est. to be divided as follows Viz, I give & bequeath unto my two Sisters Elizabeth McFaddin & Jannet McFaddin & brother James McKnight all my real & personal Estate each to have an equal share of the same & to enjoy & posses as soon as conveniently after my death. & if my Brother James dies before he is twenty one years of Age his part is to belong to his Surviving Sisters, And I do Appoint John J McFaddin & Samuel McFaddin my ~~Executors~~ Executors I disannul every other Will- I ratify & Confirm this Instrument of writing to be my last Will & test<sup>mt</sup> In Witnefs whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day & yr first above written --
