Singleton^d two Children Joseph and Elizabeth two Negroes that is winey and abram to them and their heirs for Ever to be Equally Devided be tween them Thurdly I give and bequeth to My Daughter Elizabeth three Negroes that is Sam Jene and harry and the said Elizabeth to pay Sarah vaghan fifteene pound forthly I give and bequeath to My Daughter Sarah vaghan two Negroes that is toney and Milley to her and the heirs of hur bodey for Ever Fiftly I give and bequeath to My Sun Matthew Singleton two Negroes that is top and Ben to him and the heirs of his Body for Ever Sixly I give and bequeath to My Sun Ruh. Singleton^d ten Shillings Sterling to him and his heirs for Ever Eightly I give and bequeath to My Sun Joseph Singleton ten Shillings to him and the

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 heirs of his body for Ever and I give to Matthew Singleton and
 John Singleton all that plantation or track of land I now live
 on that is five hundred acres to them and the heirs of them^{ir}
 Bodes for Ever to be Equally Devided between them and the Re-
 mainder of My Estate I will it May be Devided between My four
