~~Stamper of Mecklenburg County in the State of Virginia--~~Secondly I give and bequeath to Lucy Powell above mentioned, a certain black horse which I lately purchased of Charles Lynch-----

Thirdly I give and bequeath to the said Lucy Powell and her daughter Lucellus Purdew all the obligations and other papers of consequence now in my prfsefsion-----

Fourthly I give devise and bequeath to my Neice Polly Stamper, oldest daughter of my brother William Stamper, of Mecklenburg County in the State of Virginia, a tract of land containing one hundred and ten acres, situate in Brunswick County in the said State of Virginia which I purchased of one Samuel Bagley-----

Lastly I do hereby appoint my said brother William Stamper and Joseph Hightower Executors of this ~~my~~ last will and Testament, hereby revoking all wills hereto fore by me made and executed, and do de- declare this to be my last Will and Testament In Witnefs where of I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this twenty first day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
