And as touching such worldly estate as it has pleased god to blefs me with in this life I give memise and dispose of in the following manner and form .--Carter First I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Margret to the Hiers of her body the tract of Land where I now live with all the improvements thereon, Containing 350 Acres more or lefs, Also the lower part of the tract on which James R Carter now lives the line to Commence where the Old Gin house formerly stood and run so as to embrace one third part of that tract I also give and bequeath to my Daughter and after her to her Hiers twenty five Negroes (Viz) Aguilla, Judge Moriah Annak, Ned, Billy, Hariot, Shadrick, Billy Louifa, March, Lydia, Minda Levicy, Sabine Arthur, John, Matilda Joseph, Stephen and Nancy, bequeath to my beloved son James Dwyer the balance of the above mentioned tract of land on which James R Carter now lives which original 640 Acres; I also give and bequeath tract Contains by to James Dwyer a tract of Land Contain 150 Acres lying between Capt Caleb Rembert and David Scott, the above mentioned Land a lot of twenty one Negroes I give and bequeath to James Dwyer and to this Lawful heirs of his body the names of Sa Negroes are as follows.
