Parish Planter, being Sick & weak in Body but of Perfect Mind &
Memory; Than to be Given unto God. calling unto mind the Mortality
of my Body, & knowing that it is appointed for all Men once to Die
do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament, that is to say,
principally & first of all, I give & recommend my soul into the
hand of Almighty God that gave it, & my body I recommend to the
earth, to be Buried in Decent Christian burial at the Discretion
of my Executors; nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection
I shall receive the same again, by the Right & power of God. And
as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to
~~Give~~ me in this life, I give, devise, & dispose of the same in
the following Manner & Form:

First I give to my Sons James & Thomas Commander, the sum of Five
Shillings Sterling to each of them, and the sum of Five Shillings
Sterling Money to each of my Deceased Children (which I had by my
first wife) or their Heirs Likewise to all the Children which are
married, that I had by my Last wife I have given them their per
already which is a small Stock of Cattle, to each of them, And
my upper Tract of Land which I Bought of John Egan I Desire may be
equally Divided in the Vident, the half for my Son Samuel & the
other half for my Son Joseph, also the Plantation I now reside
on I desire that Mary my Dear wife may reside on during her idow-
hood, afterwards to be for my youngest Son Jefse, And I do desire
that at all the rest of my Estate my continue together as it is for
the Term of five years, for the Support of my wife & young Children,
then I desire that my wife may have a Horse or Mare malle &
Mallie, her Choice to be hers, and Likewise my Negro wench Ned

First I give to my Sons James & Thomas Commander, the sum of Six Shillings Sterling to Each of them, and the Sum of Five Shillings Sterling Money to each of my Deceased Children (which I had by my first wife) or their Heirs likewise to all the Children which I married, that I had by my Last wife I have given them their share already which is a small Stock of Cattle, to each of them, And my upper Tract of Land which I Bought of John Egan I Desire ^{may} be equally Divided in the ^{first} ~~widst~~, the half for my Son Samuel & the other half for my Son Joseph, also the Plantation I now reside on I desire that Mary my Dear wife may reside on during idleness, afterwards to be for my youngest Son Jefee, And I do desire that all the rest of my Estate may continue together as it is for the Term of five years, for the Support of my wife & young Children, then I desire that my wife may have a Horse or Mare riding saddle, her Choice to be hers, and Likewise my Negro wench Venus I Desire my wife may have her, with her, to Labour for me during the Natural Life of my wife, also my wife to have a good feather bed furniture, And all the rest of my estate I desire may be Divided into four equal parts a part to each of my four Youngest Children I had by my last wife, which is, Samuel, Jos Jefee, and Martha my Daughter, And the above said Negro wench Venus, at the Death of my wife, both she and her Increase if any

after the Term of five years shall be Equally Divided between
my four Youngest Children above Named. -- And I do Likewise Con-
~~stitute~~ & appoint my Three Younges Sons & mely Samuel, Joseph, &
Jesse Commander to be the Executors of this my last Will and Test-
ment, An I do hereby utterly Disallow, revoke and Disannul all
& every other former Testaments, His Legacies, Bequests & Ex-
ecutors by me in any ways before Named, willed & bequeathed;
ratifying and confirming this, and no other to be my last Will
and Testament.

& Eighty three.
