Item It is my will and Desire that my Estate be Equally Divided Bêtween my Beloved wife and my three Children, Isabella, Samuel & Mary my Slaves to be kept together and not Divided untill my son My is to be maintained and my Children maintained Comes of Age. and Educated out of the Estate my Daughter Issabella is to have part when of Age or Married. Item. I give and Bequeath unto my Son Samuel 400 acres of Land that I now live on when he arrives to One And Twenty years of Age or sooner if my Executors thinks proper and if he Dies without heirs it is be Divided between my It is my Desire that 100 Acres of Land on the. two Daughters. South Side of Santee three miles from Nelsons ferry on the head of Eandy Hiver be sold at the Discretion of my Executors. I do Appoint my Beloved Wife and William Little John Paisley if he will Act Sole Executors of this my last will and Testament-In witness whereof I the N. Sam. Nelson have to this my Testament Set my hand and Seal the Day and year/ above written -Signed and Delived Samuel Weilson in presents of
