I give unto my great grand Daughter Martha Moore Kendrick daughter of James Kendrick one Negro woman Named Henrietta and her increase but should the Said Martha Moore Kendrick die leaving No lawfull issue then--the above Named Negro and her increase to be divided between her Surviveing Brothers and Sisters or their lawfull issue

Item 2^d

I give unto my grand Daughter Sarah ann Kendrick--wife of James Kendrick during her natural life and after her death to be equally divided between ~~her~~ Children--the three following Negroes Namely Milly-Mary--and Hercules--and their increase--als all the money and note I may have at the time of my death--after paying my lawfull debts Also all the crop of every discription wheather in the house or in the field--one carriage and harness one waggon and hind gear--one feather bed--bedsted and furniture--two Sets of Curtains--one wool Mattress one Moos Mattrafs, one dozen winser chairs all my warring apparel all the countinpins Sheets and ~~Blanket~~ Blanket that I have bought or made Since the death of my Husband also half Dozen Silver Table Spoons--half dozen pap Spoons also Silver--half dozen Silver Teaspoons--all the Horses. that I may own at the time of death--and all the Household and Kitchen furniture that I have bought Since the death of my Husband or may buy here

I Give unto my grandSon Warren E. Sanders--two hundred Dollars to be paid out of my Estate-----

Kendrick as my Executors to this my last will and testament-in
testamony whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this
