Item I Lend to my beloved wife Sarah Deas, the ~~home~~ & plantation I now Live on in the state and County above named, during her Life at her death to Return to my Son Allen Deas , if he Should dy before he Comes of age to return to my Son Danill Deas, if he also should dy under age then to go to my Son William Deas--also I Lend to my bloved wife Sarah Deas Eight Cows & Calves 1 feather bed & furneture Six Knives & forks two pewter dishes Six Pewter plates one negroe boy named Dave all my Stock of hogs & plantation tools during her Life and after her death to be equally Devided among my Children as follows Easter Deas, Nancy Deas, Minney Deas, polley Deas, William Deas, Daniel Deas, Sealy Deas, Allen Deas

Item. I giv to my Son William Deas the yongue Colt that now Sucks.

Item I giv to my Son Daniel Deas the Bay filley

Item. my will is that the Black mair should be equally Devided among my daughters as follows Easter Deas, Nancy Deas Minney Deas, polley Deas, Sealy Deas.

Item my will is that the remaining part of my house hold furneture and Stock may be Equally Devided to my Children as follows, Easter Deas, Nancy Deas, Minney Deas, polley Deas, William Deas, Daniel Deas, Sealy Deas Allen Deas, - as they Come to age or Marry to them or thereheirs or afsigns for Ever

Item my will is that the Money Shall be Laid out to the best advantage for the use of the State as the Executors Shall think fit.--
