I give and bequeath unto my son David Henderson one Shilling to be considered his full share of my Estate Also one Shilling to each of my Grand Sons (Children of my Daughter Mary Player Dec^d)-----

I give and bequeath all the remainder of my estate to my Daughter Hester Green

I do hereby Nominate and appoint my Son in Law Lewis Green Executor of this my last will and Testament, hereby revoking and making Void ~~all and every other will and wills at any time heretofore made and~~ do declare this to be my last will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this Eleventh day of April In the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and fifteen
