In the name of god Amen I Thomas Baggs of Sumter Destrict and State of South Carolina being in a weak State of ~~body and mind~~ in health but of found and disposing mind and memory and calling to mind the mortality of the body and immortality of the foul do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament--Imprimis It is my Will and desire that my beloved wife Elizabeth mary be continued on my plantation and to be equally with my Children supported from the profits of my plantation during her widowhood as my widow provided she continues to reside on my plantation and manages for the benefit of my children I also give and bequeath to her my beloved wife Elizabeth mary my bay Horse deer legs in lieu of dower and every other confideration or demand on my Estate except her maintenance as above specified----Idem I will and desire that the residue of my Estate real and perfonal be equally divided betwixt my three Daughters maria america mary Elizabeth and Elvira Cantey as they arrive at the ages of eighteen years old or on the days of their marriage ~~xxxx~~ but should either of them die under age or unmarried then their part of parts of the Estate is to be equally divided among the survivors-----

I do hereby nominate and appoing my true and trusty friends Charles Cantey and Samuel Little Executors to this my last will and Testament made this 11th day of May, 1810--
