And as for the Worldly goods it hath pleased god to blefs me with I give and bequeath in the following Manner-----

First I give and bequeath to my Beloved Couzen Jared Neilson The Two Tracts of Land & Ho't of John Canale and William Candle of the Mifaisippi Territory the same Tract Lying on Cowpen Swamp Joining Land laid out to John Gibson the other on Rocky Bluff Swamp Joining the said Gibsons Tract And the thirs part of my personal Estate Except the Household and kitchen Furniture to Him and his Heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my Beloved Couzen Davis Neilson Junr One third of my personal Estate and my Household and kitchen Furniture and the Wagons of the Hier of my Negros untill they are Come or sent for by one of the Other Legatees to Him and his Heirs forever-----

Item I give and bequeath to my Half Brother Richard Bradford the son of Nathaniel Bradford the other Third of my Personal Estate to him and his Heirs forever It is my will and Desire that my Estate which is one Family of Negroes shall not be devided but be Valued and one of the Legatees to take the whole of them together And make up payment to the other Legatees thier third part of the Valuation of them. And as they are Now in the Mifaisippi Territory Which ever of the Legatees goes for them the other shall be at

ing the said Gibsons Tract And the thirs part of my personal Estate  
Except the Household and kitchen Furniture to Him and his Heirs  
forever

Item I give and bequeath to my Beloved Couzen Datis Neilson Jnr  
One thirs of my personal Estate and my Household and kitchen  
Furniture and the Wagons of the Hier of my Negroes untill they  
are Come or sent for by one of the Other Legatees to Him and his  
Hiere forever-----

Item I give and bequeath to my Half Brother Richard Bradford the  
son of Nathaniel Bradford the other Third of my Personal Estate  
to him and his Hiere forever It is my will and Desire that my Es-  
tate Which is one Family of Negroes shall not be devidid but be  
Valued and one of the Legatees to take the whole of them together  
And make up payment to the other Legatees thier third part of the  
Valuation of them. And as they are Now in the Mifsissippi Territory  
Which ever of the Legatees goes for them the other shall be at  
Equal Expencc in fetching them and pay the other for his Trouble.  
It is my Will and Desire that Jared Neilson Do furnish my Uncle  
David Neilson With A Mare for his Own Use and property whenever  
he shall Call for her and to be for his Use During his Life and  
at his Death to fall to his son Josiah Neilson Both her and her  
Increase to him the said Josiah Neilson and his Heirs forever---

And I Do hereby Nominat and Appoint Jared Neilson, Tho<sup>s</sup> Gordon  
and John McDonald of Linches Creek Executors of this my Last Will  
and Testament and Do Acknowledge this and no other to be my last  
Will and Testament in the presence of these Witnefs Signed Sealed  
and Delivered this <sup>10</sup> 4th Day of Jan<sup>y</sup> 1807 Anno Donna-----
