Elizabeth Chandler, & Charles P Chandler, Item I give unto my son Thomas Chandler one negroe boy named Jeffry. Item unto my daughter Elizabeth Chandler one negroe woman Mamed arah, Item, I Give unto my Son Charles . Chandler, one negtoe war man Named Bob. And my will & disire is that my wife Jane Chandler have one half of my present Growing Crop. & the balance after paying my Just debts to be Equally divided among my Children as named above And I do hereby appoint my son Charles . Chandler to be my whole & sole Executor, hereby Renouncing & revokting all wills here tofore made or Signed by me, Ac nowledgeing this to be my last will E Testament, Signed with my hand & Seal this 3rd day of July one thousand Sight Hundred Y Eighteen-Test
