Ware the Sole Executors of this my last will and Testament. and I Do hearby Disallow Revoke and disanul all and every other former Testaments Wills Legacies bequeaths and Executors by me in any ways before Named willed and bequeathed ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my Last will and testament. In witnefs wherefore I have here unto set my hand and Seal this Seventeenth Day of May one thousand Eight Hundred--Signed and Sealed by the said Thomas Jackson, as his Last will and Testament in the presents of us who in his presents and in the presents of Each other hear untow subscribe our names
