THOMAS J LENOIR

South Carolina

In the name of God amen I Thomas J Lenoir of Sumter District and State aforesaid being of sound and despoiling mind and memory but weak in body and calling to mind the uncertainty of life, and being desirous to dispose of all such worldly estate as it hath pleased God to blesse me with do make this my last will: in manner following that is to say I give unto my brother William R Lenoir all the land I am entituled to, I then desire that the ballance of my property be sold and that all moneys due me be collected and that the money so collected and the money arising from the sales of my property be applyed first to the discharge of all my just debts and that the balance thereof be equally divided between my two sisters Martha A Lenoir and Matilda A Lenoir. And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my friends Malachi P. Murphy & Hastin Jennings Executors of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all other and former wills & testaments by me heretofore made; Intestamony whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty fourth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventeen
