Daughter Mary, Two Elde Daughters first named Ellener and Elizabeth one Hundred acres of Land to be Laid out as it is now laid out adjoining Henry Durant Land being * place where the now Live I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth one Hundred acres of Land adjoining Between Samuel Newman & Thomas Cole It is my will and Testament that all the aforesaid Land give and Bequeathed by me to my Children, to be for them to use and Improve During there natural Lives and then to be Equally Divided among there Children. and so the be Continued to Devolve from one generation to an other but Should any of my Children Die without Issue there part to be Equally Divided among my Surviving Heirs and as Touching my personal Estate I order that it to be Equally Divided among all my Children and my beloved Wife her Life time and then to my Daughter Susanah I Do hereby utterly Disanull and and Revoke all other Wills and Bequeaths Heretofore made by me and I Do hereby appoint Constitute and ordain my Beloved Brother Jonathan Newman and my beloved Sons Nehemiah and Ethaliah Newman my Executors of this my Last Will and Testament In witness wherof I have Set my hand and Seal this 23 Day of July 181806
