of God.

And as touching such worldly estate as it has been pleased God to
bless me with in this life, I give demise and dispose of in the
following manner and form, First I give to my beloved wife Sarah two
negroes named Milly & Jack, during her life, I also give her forever
one horse named Selam & one ^{riding} chair also ^{one half of} all the house hold &
all her furniture & one third part of the stock, I also give her
during her life one third part of my land which at her death togeth-
er with the two aforesaid negroes and their Increase I wish to re-
turn to my Children. the balance of my Property Consisting of four
negroes, Dick, Portland, Moriah, & Ancrom, Land ^{Stock & house hold} and ~~and stock~~ I wish
furniture ^{and household & kitchen} equally divided between my Children, the stock ^{I wish kept to-}
furniture ^{my wife} together for the mutual use of the family during the widowhood, and
Sarah
when ever she may marry then I wish a division to take place two
of the stock and one half of the house hold & kitchen furnitur
thirds which kept for the use of my Children and the balance to the
use of my wife Sarah and I do hereby constitute make and ordain my
beloved wife Sarah Rembert and Francis L. Kennedy, the sole Execut-
ors of this my last will and testament, and I do hereby utterly dis-
allow revoke & disannul every former Testaments ~~ills legacies and~~
bequests and Executors by me in any wise before named Willed and
bequeathed Ratifying and Confirming this and no^t other to be my
last will & Testament. in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal this fifth day of February in the year of our Lord One

thousand & eight hundred and Twenty--- Signed sealed Published & declared by the said Thomas Rembert as his last will and Testament in his Presence and in the Presence of each other have hereunto subscribed our names.
