WILLIS HUDNALL

In the Name of God Amen -I Willis Hudnall of Sumter Destrict in the State of South Carolina- being in body but of a Sound Mind and Memory and Calling in Mine the uncertainty of Life- and being desirous to dispose of all My Worldly Estate- I do hereby make and Publish this My last Will and Testament announcing all other Wills and Testaments by me Made-----

First- I lend unto My beloved Wife Prissilla Hudnall. dureing her Widowhood or life-that tract of Land- Called the Potter Tract. and the Tract of Land Called the Fed Winkley Place- I also lend her as above Mentioned one Negro Man Named Kitt- one Negro Woman Named Bett one Negro boy Named Sam- ~~one Negro Man Named Tom~~ one Negro Man Named Isham- one Negro Woman Named Vilate one Negro Woman Named Doreafs- one Negro Girl Named Efsey- one Negro boy Named Joe- and all the Stock of Horses Cattle Hogs and Sheep-except-Such as I have herein otherwise disposed off- all this I lend to my Wife Prissilla Hudnall for the Support of her self and Family- all this I lend to her during her Widow hood and no Longer-----

Secondly-- I Give and Bequeath unto My Daughter Hannah Davis--one Negro Woman Named Rose one Girl Named Dorcas--one Negro Girl Nam,d Loney one Negro Girl named Sarah---All this I Give at my Death---

Thirdly--I Give and Bequeath unto My Son Henry Hudnall. them tracts of Land Called the Gibson Place Containing three Hundred and Seventy Acres more or lefs--one Negro Man Named Phil--one Negro Girl Named Hannah--All this I Give at My Death-----

Fourthly--I Give and bequeath unto My Son Willis Hudnall one Negro Boy Named Jim and one Horse Called Doctor. one double barrel Shot-Gun one Feather Bead all this I Give him at my Death--and after the death of My Wife Prissilla Hudnall or at her Marriage--I also Give

the Said Willis one Negro Man Kitt one Negro Woman Named Bett--one

Testaments by me Made-----

First- I lend unto My beloved Wife Prissilla Hudnall. during her Widowhood or life-that tract of Land- Called the Potter Tract. and the Tract of Land Called the Fed Winkley Place- I also lend her as above mentioned one Negro Man Named Kitt- one Negro Woman Named Bett- one Negro boy Named Sam- ~~one Negro Man Named Tom~~ one Negro Man Named Isham- one Negro Woman Named Vilate one Negro Woman Named Doreafs- one Negro Girl Named Efsey- one Negro boy Named Joe- and all the Stock of Horses Cattle Hogs and Sheep-except-Such as I have herein otherwise disposed off- all this I lend to my Wife Prissilla Hudnall for the Support of her self and Family- all this I lend to her during her Widow hood and no Longer-----

Secondly-- I Give and Bequeath unto My Daughter Hannah Davis--one Negro Woman Named Rose one Girl Named Dorcas--one Negro Girl Named Nancy one Negro Girl named Sarah---All this I Give at my Death---

Thirdly--I Give and Bequeath unto My Son Henry Hudnall. them tracts of Land Called the Gibson Place Containing three Hundred and Seventy acres more or less--one Negro Man Named Phil--one Negro Girl Named Hannah--All this I Give at My Death-----

Fourthly--I Give and bequeath unto My Son Willis Hudnall one Negro Boy Named Jim and one Horse Called Doctor. one double barrel Shotgun one Feather Bead all this I Give him at my Death--and after the death of My Wife Prissilla Hudnall or at her Marriage--I also Give the Said Willis one Negro Man Kitt one Negro Woman Named Bett--one Boy Sam and Epsey--and the two tracts of Land Called the Potter Place & Winkles Place--one Negro Man Named Isham one Boy Named Joe. ~~Isham-and-Joe-is-to-be-Valued-at-My-Wifes-Death-and-the-Said-Willis-is-to-keep-them-and-pay-the-Valuation-to-the-Lawful-Heirs-equally~~
I Also Give Willis at My death one Cow and Calf-----

Fifthly--I Give and Bequeath unto My Son Robert Hudnall. at My death one half of that--Tract of Land Called the Perry tract--that is the

upper half--also one Negro Woman Named Mourning--one Negro Man Named Tom --one Feather Bead one Cow and Calf all this I Give at my Death. and one Mare colt--also at My death-----

Sixthly. I Give and Bequeath unto my Son Jarred Hudnall the one half of that tract of Land called the Perry Tract that is the lower part of Said tract also one Negro Woman Named Vilate one Girl Named Mary--one Girl Named Saphrona and one Girl Named Sabrey--and one Feather bead and one Cow and Calf--(all this that is not lent-) to the said Jarred at My Death-----

Seventhly--I Give and Bequeath unto My Daughter Elizabeth Hudnall one Negro Woman Named Doreal one Boy Named Edmand--one Feather Bead one Cow and Calf--one tract of Land Called the Gibbs Place It is My Will that all the present Crop of every description be Kept for the use of the Family who now live at the Place or at home. I also want My three Youngest Children Robert, Jared and Elizabeth to be schooled out of the Money now in the house and the Ballance if any after paying my Just debts, be divided amongst the Legal heirs.

I also appoint and ordain Jehn Hudnall, Prissilla Hudnall and Willis Hudnall Executors to this My last Will and Testament where of I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal--This the Seventh day of October in the Year of Our Lord one thousand eight Hundred and Seventeen--
