 Last Will & Testament - first I give & Recommen^{end} my Soul to god all
 mighty that first give it to me & my Body to the Earth in Decent
 Christian Burial at the Discrefsion of my Executors- & as Touching
 such worldly goods as it has pleased god to Blefs me with in this
 life I give & Dispose of in form & manner following- first it is
 my will & Request that my Sons Thomas Wills William Wills & Joseph
 Downing Chose & appoing good & fit men for to value & appraise all
 my Lands which is to Be Equally Divided amongst them agreeable to
 such valuation & appraisment- allowing my son William to have the
 plantation whereon I now Reside Secondly I give & Bequeath to my
 son Thomas two Negroes By Name Deary- & Jude & To my son William
 I give & Bequeath Two, to wit- Mary & Rachel- & To my Daughter Mary
 I give & Bequeath Two- Isham & Sindar & it is my will that my son
 William & my daughter Mary have Each of them a Bed & furniture &
 it is my Request & Will that all my Stock of Every kind & sort to-
 gether with all others goods of Every King & Description to me in
 any wise Belonging Shall Be Equally Divided Between my Sons Tho^s
 William & my Daughter Mary & I Do hereby Constitute appoint Thomas
 Wills William Wills & Joseph Downing to be the Executors of this
 my Last will & Testament in Witnefs whereof I Set my hand & Seal
 this 20th of January-1818
