In the Name of God Amen I William Edwards being verr sick but at the present of sound Mind although weak in Body do hire make my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all m^y former Wills I bequeath my Soul to God in humbl Hope of Mercy through Jesus Christ and my Body to the Earth I leue to my blloved Wif^t Elizabeth Edwards the Plantition were I leattlie lived on the Water of Blac^c River on Pudding Swamp of two hundred Acres and six Negroes Iesseck Charlat and and Rob Seby Ben Abram to hir own Desposse^t lick ways leue to my Neffer Charles Edwards one Negro Fell named Littar but at the Death of my Wif^t the Plantition to be left to Jamesoots the Oldest Son of Jacob Yoots Juner decess I acknowledge this to be my last Will and Testament. February 11^d 1782.
