the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the
mighty power of God and as touching Worldly Estate wherewith it
hath pleased God to blefs me in this life I give, desire and
dispose of the same in the following manner and Form---First it
is my desire that all my lawful debts shall be paid
Secondly I give and bequeath unto my nephew John Moody a Tract
of Land containing One Hundred acres lying between Samney swamp
and Halfway swamp and that my Mother Luvicy Gilbert shall live and
have Quiet perefson therein during her life- Thirdly I give
and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Susanna and Child Sarah all the
remaining property such as Negroes, Lands, Stock and household
furniture when an Equal division shall be made of the Estate
