Planter of Sumpter Distr & State of South Carolina being of Sound mind & good memory though indisposed in Body--Calling to Mind the uncertainty of Life--Do Make this my last will and Testament in the manner & form following. First After paying all my Just Debts & funeral expences, I give & bequathe unto by my beloved Daughter Sarah Newman one Negroe Gerril Named Lotte one Feather Bed and furniture and twenty five Dollars----Second-I Give & bequathe to my beloved Daughter Ge. elopy Newman one Negroe boy named July-one Feather Bed and furniture and twenty five Dollars----Third. I give & bequeathe to my by beloved Daughter Elizabeth, one Negroe geril named Rose and one feather Bed & furniture and Fifty Dollars----Fourth- I give & bequathe to my Grandson John Newman one hundred acres of Land-part of the Tract I now occupy adjoining Stephen Mitchel----Fifth-The Balance of the Tract I live on ~~see~~ I bequathe to my beloved Son Drury Newman---Sixthly-My Negroe wench Jude to be sold and devided between my Sons equally after paying my Debts--Seventhly-My Negroe boy Butler, Stock and house hold furniture to be Sol to defray my Debts----If the Seventh Clause is Sufficient to pay my Debts--then the Negroe wench Jude mentioned in the Sixth to remain with my Daughters during ~~all the time~~ the time they Live Single after the marriage of the last of Them the Said wench Jude and her Issue to be Sold & Equally Divided--between my my Beloved Sons Maughen C. Newman & W^m Newman and Drury Fury Newman--Lastly I do hereby nominate constitute & appoint Stephen Mitchel, Gersher Benbow & W^m Reaves-Exacutors of this my last will & Teftament-In Witnes whereof I have Set my hand and Seal this 18th Day of March 1815-----
