WILLIAM ROBINSON

In the Name of God amen This second Day of November 1795 I William Robinson of the County of Salem and State of South Carolina being old weake and in a declining State of Body But of Sound and perfect mind and memory and Calling to mind the uncertainty of Tempord State and that all must yield unto Death when the Lord Calls and that Settling of my Temporel Estate order give and dispose of the same in manner and form following to wit imprimis

Item I give and Bequeath unto my son Toney Robinson five Shilling Starling

Item I give and Bequeath unto my step son Joshua Coker five Shillings Starling

Item I give and Bequeath unto my son William Robinson five Shillings Starling

Item I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Winney Robinson five Shillings Starling

Item I give and Bequeath unto my <sup>daughter</sup> Sarah Yates five Shillings Starling

Item I give and Bequeath unto my son Willes Robinson five Shillings Starling

Item I give and Bequeath unto my step son Noah Coker five Shillings Starling

Item I give and Bequeath unto my son Jonathan Robinson ~~four hundred~~ fifty acres of Land and one gun

Item I give and Bequeath unto my son Soverin Robinson fifty acres of Land on the North Side of the Land

Bequeath Item I give unto my Beloved wife Mary Robinson all the Rest of my whole Estate her Natural life tame or her widowhood and after her

Item I give and Bequeath unto my son Toney Robinson five Shilling Starling

Item I give and Bequeath unto my step son Joshua Coker five Shillings Starling

Item I give and Bequeath unto my son William Robinson five Shillings Starling

Item I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Winney Robinson five Shillings Starling

Item I give and Bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Yates five Shillings Starling

Item I give and Bequeath unto my son Willes Robinson five & Shillings Starling

Item I give and Bequeath unto my step son Noah Coker five Shillings Starling

Item I give and Bequeath unto my son Jonathan Robinson ~~one hundred~~ acres of Land and one gun

Item I give and Bequeath unto my son Soverin Robinson fifty acres of Land on the North Side of the Land

Item I give unto my Beloved wife Mary Robinson all the Rest of my whole Estate her Natural life time or her widowhood and after her death or marriage to be Equally divided amongst my three Children Namely Martha Benny Kitty and John Robinson

And hereby Revoking disannulling and making void all other and former will or wills Testament or Testaments and declare This and Th<sup>t</sup> is only to Be my Last will and Testament
