Item I give and Bequeath unto my beloved Five Daughters Name~~ly~~ Ann, Rebecca, Elizabeth, Mary and Elender, All my personal Estate Consisting of One Negro fellow Named Harry Stock of every Kink house hold and Kitchen furniture My present Crop all Debts due Me after taken out what I Shall Will Otherwise hereafter to them and thier Heirs forever

Item I give and Bequeath unto My beloved Daughter Rebecca five Shillings:

Item I give unto Martha Ridgway fourty Three Dollars which She has Received Twenty five already in a Note on Frederic Carter to her and her heirs forever.---

My will and Desire is that my Executors hereafter Mentioned do keep my five Children Namely Ann, Rebecca, Elizabeth, Mary & Elender, on My plantation where I now live untill they come of age or Marry without My Executors do find that they cannot Keep the property together without it wasting is so then it to bee Sold on a Credit with Interest

Lastly In Order to Carry this my last Willand Testament into Effect and to Execute the Same I have Ordained & Appointed My Friends John Ridgell Sen^r and George Andrews My Executors to this my last Will and Testament I Witnefs hereunto I have Set My hand & Seal this
