Itam I give and bequeth to my Daughter Mariah Boneau Taylor and Lawful begotten ifsue one Ne ro Girl named charlotte With her futur ifsue /Itam/ I sive and bequeth to my Grand son George Washington White one negro named Tenah with her future ifsue to him and his Lawful ifsue Itam the Rest and Refsadue of My Personal Property is to Remain on my Plantation for the Support and mintaneanc of My Wife Mary Taylor and my Daughters .. hich may be Unmaried at My death during the Lifetime of my wife Mary Taylor and at her death the hole of my Personal Property not already equthed to be Equal Divided amonght and my Grand Son George Tashington White to Shear and Shear alike to them and the Lawful heirs of their Body but if one or more of my Children or Grandson shall die before that time leavingifsue that ifsue is to have thich the parent Wowoud have been intitled to if liveing Itam/ it is my will and desire that if Either of my Children or Said Grandson Shall die under age or without leaveing Living ifsue his or her part of my Property is to Return to my Surviving heir it is my will and desire also my Flantation and Lands Shall Remain for the use and benefit of my Daughters as long as any one of them Shall Remain unmaried and at the Death or marrage of all my daughters that is Single then Said Lands to be Sold at Fublic oction on a Credit of twelve Months by my Executors and the Money arising from Such

Lastly I nominate and appoint My Son Sam! P. Taylor my friends S.E. lowden Sam! R. Mowson and William Plowden Executors to this my last will an Testament Sign! Seald and pronounc! as my last will and Testament this fourth day of March Eighteen hundred and twenty one in presence of us )
