Horses Such as are not in Amediate use on the plantation and a Negro
Girl named Befs to be sold for the benefit of my Creditors
Item I give and Bequath to My Son Saml P. Taylor one Negro Man Named
Ruffin /Itam/ I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Nelson Taylor
and her Lawful begotten ifssue one Negro Woman Named Sally with her
future ifssue Itam/ Give and bequeth to my Daughter Susannah Eliza-
beth Taylor and her Lawful begotten ifssue one Negro Girl named Dar-
cus and her Future ifssue. Itam I give and bequeth to my Daughter
Mariah Boneau Taylor and Lawful begotten ifssue one Negro Girl named
charlotte With her futur ifssue /Itam/ I give and bequeth to my
Grand son George Washington White one negro named Tenah with her
future ifssue to him and his Lawful ifssue Itam the Rest and Refsadue
of My Personal Property is to Remain on my Plantation for the Sup-
port and mintaneanc of My Wife Mary Taylor and my Daughters which
may be Unmarried at My death during the Lifetime of my wife Mary Ta-
lor and at her death the hole of my Personal Property not already
bequethed to be Equall^d Divided amongst ^{my Children} and my Grand Son George
Washington White to Shear and Shear alike to them and the Lawful
heirs of their Body but if one or more of my Children or Grandson
shall die before that time leaving ifssue that ifssue is to have which
the parent Wowou^d have been intitlled to if liveing
Itam/ it is my will and desire that if Either of my Children or Said
Grandson Shall die under age or without leaveing Living ifssue his or
her part of my Property is to Return to my Surviving heirs it is my
will and desire also my Plantation and Lands Shall Remain for the
use and benefit of my Daughters as long as any one of them Shall
Remain unmarried and at the Death or marrage of all my daughters that
is Single then Said Lands to be Sold at Public octioon on a Credit
of twelve Months by my Executors and the Money arising from Such

Sail to be Equally Divided amongst my Lawful heirs Shear and alike
Lastly I nominate and appoint My Son Sam^l P. Taylor my friends S.E.
Plowden Sam^l R. Mowson and William Plowden Executors to this my
last will an Testament Sign^d Seald and pronounc^d as my last will
and Testament this fourth day of March Eighteen hundred and twenty
one in presence of us)
