I do heareby utterly revoke Disanul & Disallow all other former Wills by me made allowing this to be my last will & Testament & I dwo also Appoint John Baker Jofeph Swales & Stephen Jones Executors of my last will & Testament In witnes whereof I have sat m, hand & Seal this Seventh day of May one thousand Eigh hundred & Eight--Signed Sealed publackley prounounced & declared to be the last Will & Testament of the Testator in the presents of-----
