that is to say) First I Give and bequeath unto my wife Marthew Woodson Eleven Negroes Named, Ben, Peter, Sal, Sam, Hanna, Essex, Jacob, Esaw, Phillis, Jo. and Jude, I also give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Marthew Woodson all my Stock Viz. Horses Cows Sheep and Hogs. I also Give and bequeath unto my Beloved wife Marthew Woodson all my household Furniture and all my working such as Plows Hoes axes & I also give and bequeath unto my Eldest Brothers son Talton Woodson two dollers I also Give and bequeath unto my Brother James Woodson the sum of two dollers which said two Legacies or sum of mony I will and order shall be paid to the said respective Legaties within six month after my decease. I Further Give and devise unto John Hughes Brother to my beloved wife Marthew Woodson all that my messuage or tenement of Land Containing two Hundred acre s situated Lying and Being in Union County Together with/ all and Every the premisis thereunto Belonging unto the Said John Hughes his heirs and assigns Forever. But to Remain in the full possession of my Beloved wife Marthew Woodson untell her death Whom I hereby appoint Executrix with her Brother Thomas Hughes of this my Last will and Testament Hereby Revoking all former will be me made In Witness whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this forth day of November in the Year of our Lord jone thousand Seven Hundred and Ninty nine
