make this my last will and Testament First I Bequeath my Soul to

Decent manner at the Discretion of my Executors not Doubting of
a General Resurrection, And as for what goods or worldly effects
God hath been pleased to bestow upon me I order & Dispose of in
the followin manner and form, that is to say I order that all my
& funeral Expences
Just Debts x be paid out of the whole--Imprimis I order the
plantation or tract of land or which I now live be Equally Div-
ded among three of my Sons viz Isaac Ephraim & John Isaac to
have his pat laid of Joining the Tract he now owns John's to
Enclide the New house Ephraim to have the lower end-I also order
that
x my son Hught and my Son in law James McMullen and my Son in
law Andrew Thomson Each of them have have one Guinea paid out
of my moveables I also order that my wearing apperrel Be Divided
among my three Sons viz Isaac Ephraim & John as they themselves
may agree I also order that the Remainder of Moveable Be
Sold &
viz.
Equally Divided among my five Sons Daniel James Isaac Ephraim
& John I Constitute and ^appoint my Son Isaac and Rich Thomson
to be the Executors of this my last will & testament made By
me and Confirming this my last will and testament in witness
thereunto Set my hand & Seal 1st day of Novmbr 1800
