Carolina and Countey of Union Shoo Maker Being Very Sick and
Weak in Body, But of perfect Mind and Mamory thanks Be Given
unto God Calling unto Mind the Mortality of my Body and know-
ing that it is Appointed for all Men once to Die Do make and
ordain this My Last will and Testment that is to Say Princi-
pally and first of all, I give and Recomand my Soul unto the
Hand of Almighty God that Give it and my Body I Recommend to
the Earth to be buried in Decent Christen Buriel at the Dis-
cretion of My Executors Nothing Doubting But the generel Res-
urrection I Shall Recve the Same again by the Mighty power of
God and as touching Such Worldy Estate whare with it has
please ~~me~~ to Bliss me in this Life I give Demiss and Dispose
of the Same in the following Manner and form first I give and
Bequoth to, James Nogher and William Nogher Two Hundred Eakers
of Land Joining James Saveges and Richert Eades to be Devided
Equaly By Two Honest Men by Paying John Nogher five pound a
pece when He Come of age, the Remand of the Land I Leave to
my wife and Familey to my Son Joseph Nogher Comes of age and
then I give it to him Paying John Nogher five pounds, I give
James Noger the Small Bay Near at Paying four pounds to the
estate at Delivery, the Cow and yearling that I give John
Nogher I give to him Still the Rest of the Personal Property
to be Valued By three Man and to be Divided Betwixt my wife
Mary Nogher and Elisebat Nogher and Paggay Nogher my Doghters
Each of them an Equal Share when the Come of age the are to
get there Share of Demanded My wife Mary Nogher is to have her
Share During her Life or Widewhood and my son Joseph Nogher

is to have it at the Expiration of that time, I Constitute
and appoint John Nogher James Nogher and William McCreight
Executors of this my Last will and testament I Do Revoke and
Dessanole all others mad By me Givin under my hand this Twen-
tey Day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven
Hudred and
