William my Negroe Boy Named Titus and all that plantation and tract
of Lands of 200 Acres more or less^s whereon I now live to have and
to hold the same with all things there unto belonging his heirs and
assigns forever provided and on Condotion that he shall not hinder
my wife Rebecca his mother from proassessing and enjoying the same
for and during her natural life or as much of the same as she shall
require-----

Item. I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Brandon the sum of
Ten pounds Sterling Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter
Hannah the sum of Forty pounds Sterling-----

Item. I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Brandon the sum of Ten pounds Sterling Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Hannah the sum of Forty pounds Sterling-----

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Elinor the sum of Forty pounds Sterling Item. My will is further that all the remainder of my Estate be collected and brought together of nature or kind so ever and I give and bequeath the same to my beloved wife Rebecca and my will is that ~~she~~ pay out of the same the Several sums of mone to my Children as above mentioned and I do give and bequeath to my said wife my negroe Girl Ester for and during her natural life and after her decease I do give the same Negroe to my son Isaac to have and to hold to him his heirs and assigns And I do hereby
