 Item, I give and bequeath to my son George all the Tract of Land
 Belonging to me that lyeth on Buffelow Creek with the previledges
 and appurtenances thereof to have and to hold the same his heirs
 and assigns forever. Item. I give and bequeth to my son Isaac
 my Neg^r or Boy named paul, Item. I give and bequeath to my son
 William my Negroe Boy Named Titus and all that plantation and tract
 of Land^s of 200 Acres more or less^s whereon I now live to have and
 to hold the same with all things there unto belonging his heirs and
 assigns forever provided and on Condetion that he shall not hinder
 my wife Rebecca his mother from prossessing and enjoying the same
 for and during her natural life or as much of the same as she shall
 require-----

Item. I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Brandon the sum of
 Ten pounds Sterling Item I give and be ueath to my Daughter
 Hannah the sum of Forty pounds Sterling-----
 Item I give and be ueath to my Daughter Elinor the sum of Forty
 pounds Sterling Item. My will is further that all the remainder
 of my Estate be collected and brought together of nature or kind

so ever and I give and bequeath the same to my beloved wife Rebecca
and my will is that ~~he~~ pay out of the same the Several sums of mone
to my Children as above mentioned and I do give and beueath to
