Inprimis It is my will & I do order all my Just Debts and Funeral Expenses to be paid by my Executors herein after mentioned out of such apart of my personal Estate as they may think can best be spared for that purpose - Item It is my will that my beloved wife Margaret shall keep possession & have the profits arising from my plantation for her support during her widow hood Together with all the personal Estate now in my possession . Except such as my Executors may have Occasion to dispose of for the purpose Aforesaid . Item I give and bequeath to my son Robert Norman all my land now at this time in his possession being and bound on the Eastern side of Johns Creek be the same more or less to him and his heirs forever. also Ten Acres to be taken off my Fields at the upper end of the same lying on the western side of the said creek which said Ten Acres ( he my son Robert ( ) is to have no use of during his Mothers widowhood with out her consent . Item . I give and bequeath to my two sons Thomas & John after the Death or Marriage of their Mother all and Singular my Land s & Improvements lying on the eastern side of Johns Creek aforesaid by them to be professed and enjoyed and to be Equally divided and valued

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widow hood Together with all the personal Estate now in my  
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Ten Acres ( he my son Robert ( ) is to have no use of during  
his Mothers Widowhood with out her consent . Item . I give and  
bequeath to my two sons Thomas & John after the Death or Marriage  
of their Mother all and Singular my Land s & Improvements lying  
on the eastern side of Johns Creek aforesaid by them to be  
professed and enjoyed and to be Equally divided and valued  
between them by two men Appointed and Chosen by my Executors  
they paying the sum of Fifteen pounds Sterling between to  
my Executors for the use and behoof of my son George in such  
pay as they my said Executors shall think proper . Item It is my  
will that my son George have the privilege of his <sup>home with his</sup> Mother during  
her Widow hood and that my Said Executors shall pay to him the  
Aforesaid sum of Fifteen pounds Sterling at their own discre-

tion from time to time as they shall think his necessaries

Require after the death or Marriage of his Mother but if he  
shou'd die before he receives his Legacy . then it shall be  
divided equally between mysaid Sons Thomas & John . Item I

give and bequeath to my son Jonathan The sum of five Shillings  
Sterling to my son David the sum of Five Shillings Sterling . to

my Daughter Elizabeth the sum of Five Shillings Sterling . to my  
Daughter Irene the sum of Five Shillings Sterling to be paid to  
each and every of them after the death of theri Mother out of  
Personal estate . Item . I give and bequeath to my daughter

Lydiaone Cow and Galf after the death of her Mother or when my  
said wife may think proper. Item . I give and bequeath all the  
remainder or Residue of my Estate after the Death or Marriage

of y wife to my sons Thomas & John and my Daughter Mary to be  
equally divided between them by my Executors & if either of them  
shou'd die before that time it shall be divided in like manner

between the other two . And I do hereby nominate Constitute and  
appoint my beloved Sons Jonathan & David to be my sole Executors  
of this my last will and Testament Ratifyng and Confirming t

this and no other to be Mt last Will & Testament . In witness
