 to my Son Charles paty five Shilling item I give and Bequeth to my
 Son Jesse paty five Shilling item I give and Bequeth to my
 Daughter Deliah mullins one Cow and Calf item I giv and Bequeth
 to my two youngest Sons Namely Lorobabel paty and Joshua paty all
 my Lands and plantation to them and there heirs for Ever to Be
 Equelly Devided Betwan them when they Both Come of age and if
 either of them Should Dy without have the othe to have it and
 also the two thirds of the profits ariseing on the plantation
 untel they Come of age and I also Do Constitute and apoint my
 Loving wife Deliah paty and my Loving Son John paty and my trusty
 friend Turner Kendrick to Be my Executors to this my Last
 will and testament
