I John Savage Sen^r of the District of Union and State of South Carolina being in a low State of health and weak in body but of perfect mind and Memory thanks be given unto God, Calling unto mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all Men once to die, do Make and ordain this to be My last Will And Testament that is to Say principally and first of all I give and Recommend My Soul into the hand of Almighty God that Gave it & My body I Recommend to the Earth to be buried in decent Christian burial At the discretion of MY Executors nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection I Shall Receive the Same again by the Mighty Power of God. And As touching Such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life I give demise and dispose of the Same in the following Manner and form

First I give and bequeth to Sarah my dearly beloved Wife Such a part of My Real And personal Estate as She May beentitled to bylaw in case that no will be made

Also, I give & bequeth to my Son Will^m the tract of Land on which I now live Containing Three hundred and Seventy one Acres, Together with the Negro Woman Jeen & hir Child -

Also, I give & Bequeth to My Son Joshua the tract of Land on which he now lives also one Cow and Calf which is at this time in his possession also I give the Negroe Girl Named Doll to my Son Joshua and Child the Child.

Also I give and bequeth to My Son John Two hundred acres of Land lying on Trevillers Creek - -

Also I give and bequeth to My Daughter Anne the Negro Girl named Nance -

It is Likewise My desire that the Remainder of my land unbequethed be equally devided between My Daughters Anne Sarah and

Rebecca
Also I Give and Bequath all Beding and housel furniture to Be

Equally Devided Between My Son William John and Joshua and Anne
 and Sarah & Rebeka my three Daughters also it is my will that
 aney of my Sons or Daughters that has Got aney Port of My Pro-
 perty Now in possion it Be allow^d in then Those also I allow My
 Stock of horses Cows and Sheep and hogs Be Equarley Devided
 among my three Sons and three Daughters above mentioned also I
 and Vesals
 give to my Son William My Still x also I Give to my Son Joshua
 and hind gears
 my wagg and a New Iron to put on a wagon - also I give all
 my plantation tools to gither with Some Corpentr tools to my
 Son^s William and Jshue also I Give my Gun to my Son Joshua
 also I Give to my Daughter Margrat one Doller.
 Also I apoint My Wife Sarah and James Savog Juner to Be My Ex-
 ecutter -
